What is the Summer Tutoring Program for Kids?

- A free program to help children in grades K to 6 (English, French Immersion, or Francophone) who have difficulties with reading, writing or math
- The program is 8 weeks long
- Each child receives one hour of private tutoring each week
- The learning activities are fun and designed to meet your child's learning needs

What are our goals?

- to help your child maintain and improve his or her skills over the summer months
- to meet your child's individual needs in a positive atmosphere that promotes personal development and confidence

How will you know if your child is in the program?

Your school resource teacher will let you know if your child has been referred to this program.

A tutor will contact you in late June to set up tutoring sessions for your child.

If more children are referred than the tutor can handle, we will create a waiting list.

A tutor will let you know if your child is on a waiting list and contact you when space becomes available.

Please note:

Please follow the rules so that we can help as many children as possible.



Rules:

1. Please remember that the tutor is not responsible for your child before or after scheduled sessions. Please wait with your child until the tutor is available and pick up your child on time.
2. Your child is expected to attend at least 1 of the first 2 sessions. If your child is absent for both sessions, another child will be given his or her place for the summer.
3. If your child is going to miss a session, please call the tutor ahead of time.
4. The tutor will offer a make-up session to your child **only** if you let the tutor know ahead of time that your child will miss a session.
5. If your child misses 2 sessions without letting the tutor know, their spot will be offered to the next child on the waiting list.
